Entry & Exit

Group Limits

Please note the following guidelines around spectators and players.

There is no limit on the number of people per group if all participants are **18 years and under**. Gathering limits do not apply to players, umpires and those reasonably required to manage the activity.

GROUP LIMITS Maximum of 20 people in each space, plus coach and essential support personnel.

- A netball court is considered a 'space'.
- Where the facility has multiple courts, more than one group can be accommodated.
- Where multiple courts are in use, each group must remain in their designated 'space'.
- Groups must not cross over or mingle.

SPECTATORS. Only people required to support the participants are permitted (maximum one parent/guardian per child).

Parents/guardians are required to maintain a 1.5 metre physical distance from each other. Parents/guardians should not gather in groups of more than 10.
